

Hygiene concept for the IFTF 2021 – Workshops at Antagonhall

The Care Team was set up to take the necessary safety measures before, during and after the International Womxns' Theatre Festival IFTF 2021 to avoid a possible risk from the current pandemic of the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2. This document is intended to inform all participants about our hygiene and safety concept during our workshops. In addition, the Antagon / Protagon team confirms that all safety precautions will be taken on the basis of the local regulations of the State of Hesse and the Federal Ministry of Health with regard to socio-cultural events during the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus pandemic.

We kindly ask the following people NOT to come to the workshops:

- People who had contact within the last 14 days with a person who was found to have the corona virus.
- People with cold or flu symptoms.

Otherwise, the following hygiene rules continue to apply to ALL participants:

- Only those who have been vaccinated, recovered or tested (negative proof no more than 24 hours old) are allowed to come to the workshops. It is now mandatory to wear a mask in the stairwell, lounge areas and changing rooms. The mask can be removed again in the workshop room. Only children under 6 years of age are exempt from the mask requirement.
- A good hygiene orientation can prevent the virus. For that, we have installed a hygiene station with alcohol gel in front of our main entrance so that the outside participants can disinfect their hands before accessing the Cultural Space Protagon e.V.
- Please wash your hands with soap for 20 seconds immediately before and after the workshops.
- We have installed a mobile room air purifier Ulmair X200, a sort of HEPA filter that is efficient at removing submicron particles from the air in the training hall. The X200 sucks in the contaminated air from below and blows it into the room, cleaned, calmed, and flow-directed.
- Adhere to the sneeze-cough etiquette. If you need to sneeze or cough, please put it in the crook of your arm or in a handkerchief. If you sneeze or cough into your hands, wash your hands immediately afterwards.
- Blow your nose: If you need to blow your nose, please wash your hands with soap or use disinfectants afterwards.
- Avoid handshakes, hugs and body contact (keep the distance rule).
- Bring a surgical or protective mask of the required standards and wear it if it is not possible to keep the 1.5 m distance during the workshop.

If we observe all points with a clear conscience, we can continue to enjoy the workshops together.
